This contradictory nature is explainable because nascent aluminum reacts with oxygen or water and forms a coherent surface oxide which impedes further reaction of aluminum with the environment. This resistance is due to the inert and protective character of the aluminium oxide film which forms on the metal surface. In most environments, the rate of corrosion of aluminium decreases rapidly with time. The physical-chemical stability of the oxide film determines the corrosion resistance of the aluminium. Unlike iron and steel, aluminium does not rust or corrode in moist conditions. Its surface is protected by a natural layer of aluminium oxide. This prevents the metal from further oxidation. This self-protecting characteristic gives aluminum its high resistance to corrosion.
